






Overview Of North American Rail

- Seven Class I railroads
- Five major East-West Gateways
- Ship over two billion tons of freight annually
- Rail is 4x's more fuel efficient vs. truck
- One ton of freight can travel 470 miles on one gallon of fuel
- Oversight provided by Federal Railroad Administration (FRA)






NOPBFast Facts

- 40 miles of mainline track
- Six Class I rail connections
- Owns the Huey P. Long Bridge, one of the longest and highest, steel railroad bridges in the United States.
- NOPB is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Port of New Orleans Board of Commissioners, providing synergy within the transportation Gateway and creating a unified voice within transportation.

Sustainability

- Lease of eight new GATX locomotives to replace existing fleet of 15
 - 40% reduction in Nox
 - 50% reduction in particulates
 - 25% reduction in greenhouses gas
 - 25% reduction in fuel consumption
- Urban Rail Initiative: Community responsiveness has increased 10-fold.
 Service has improved and so has response to community concerns.
 - 2018: averaged 40-50 calls per week
 - 2019: averaging 4-5 calls per week


